








PR Act Review - Phase 1

Jurisdiction

- Who and what should be covered by the PR Act?
- How can the jurisdiction of the PR Act be maintained as the public service changes?





Standards

- Should the Keeper retain authority to establish records management standards?
- Should records management standards be mandatory for all Victorian government organisations and their employees?





Compliance

- What is the best mechanism for inspecting, monitoring and reporting compliance with the PR Act?
- What should the range of offences and penalties be?
- Should penalties for offences under the PR Act be increased to align with penalties in similar Victorian Acts?
- Should the PR Act specify the mechanism for prosecutions?





Access to Records

- Should all public records be open by default after a period of time unless there are certain grounds for restricting access?
- Should records be open by default upon transfer?
- Are the current closure periods adequate?
- Should the authority to close records/provide for special access lie with the Keeper or the Minister?
- Should there be mandatory public reporting on closure decisions?
- Should the mechanism for seeking to vary an access closure decision be through a formal appeals process?





Disposal and Transfer of Records

- What should the appropriate trigger be to transfer records?
- Should the organisation head being required to undertake a formal disposal program?
- Should the Keeper be able to compel organisations to transfer records if they are not able to justify their continued need for the records?





Review of Decisions

Key issue:

• Should there be an appeals mechanism that is applicable to a range of decisions (including closure and access)?





Alignment with Other Legislation

- Should the closure provisions align with FOI Act and PDP Act?
- Should the Keeper's authorisation be required for amending or annotating records?





Roles and Responsibilities

Advisory body

 What should its role and powers be?

Keeper of Public Records

- Are the Keeper's current powers sufficient?
- Should the PR Act include a statement of the independence of the Keeper?

Head of a Public Office

- Should there be a statement setting out their recordkeeping responsibilities?
- Should the head of a public office be responsible for ensuring compliance with the PR Act irrespective of whether a service is delivered by their organisation or externally on their behalf?





Other Issues

- Statement of purpose
- Plain English and gender neutral language
- Governance of public records not in government custody
- Co-creation of records
